

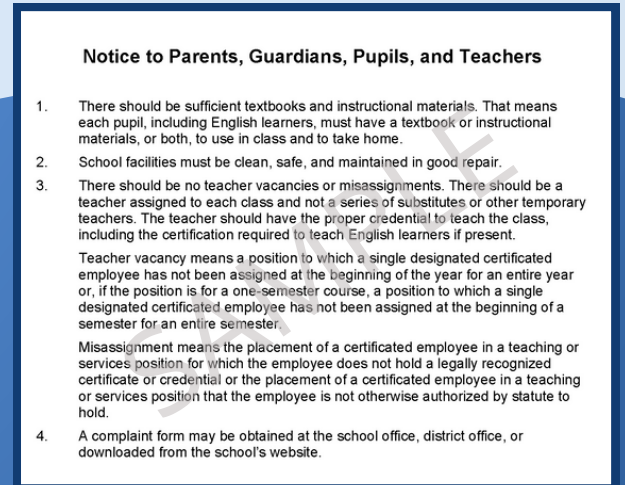
FIND THE NOTICE IN YOUR CLASSROOM!

Next time you're in a (non-charter) California public school classroom, see if you can spot a Williams Notice.



DID YOU KNOW?

Williams Notices are required as part of the settlement of a lawsuit brought against the State of California by Eliezer Williams and nearly 100 other schoolchildren. They argued that they'd been denied their state constitutional right to an equal education, including by the State's failure to ensure safe and healthy school facilities.
